


Operator's Instructions

The 6800 Bus Seat is an adjustable air suspension seat, designed to provide a high level of comfort during its many hours of service.

To enjoy the greatest degree of comfort and safety

 Read and understand these instructions and become familiar with all the controls and their functions.



Operator Inspection and Preventative Maintenance

Daily

Inspect seat belts; they must be in place and work properly. Replace worn or faulty seat belts.

Inspect all controls; they must be in place and function properly.

Inspect moving components; they must move freely. However, excessive free play indicates worn components. Repair or replace components as needed.

Weekly

Inspect all fasteners; they must be in place and tight. Be sure all mounting fasteners are torqued properly.

Inspect upholstery for cracks, cuts, tears, or breaks; replace if needed. Clean upholstery when needed.

Inspect suspension boot; it must be in place and free from cuts and cracks.

If a change in suspension performance is noticed replacing the shock absorber may be required.

WARNING

Failure to follow these procedures could cause serious or fatal injury to yourself and others:

- Read and understand operator's instructions before using seat.
- Do not use damaged or faulty seat.
- Do not adjust seat while driving.
- Always use seat belts.
- With seat properly adjusted and at maximum suspension height, you must have at least 50.8 mm (2.00 in.) of head room.
